ETI's investment in new lab equipment will allow us to better control the quality of the finished colemanite we sell to the fiber glass industry. Our customers have sophisticated analytical capabilities and expect their suppliers to meet their needs for tighter and tighter control. ETI is fulfilling that need by investing in and expanding your laboratory capabilities.

The most impressive improvement is the ore blending system which I feel will significantly improve quality through making the finished product more consistent. ETI customers rely on consistent raw materials which are delivered at a fair price. Consistency is the key to economical operation of fiber glass furnaces. The installation of the magnets to remove sources of iron from the finished product will pay back by reducing claims for variable iron content.

Active Minerals is excited to work with ETI to develop new applications for Boron minerals. We are now creating a team which will work closely with ETI sales, marketing and research staffs to develop the new applications which will drive the future demand for ETI borate products. When our plans are complete we will look for your guidance and direction on how best to implement them.
